## q cuisine: with HOBBY CHEF CHAPMAN

Baked Eggplant with Miso

Full of rich flavours, this baked eggplant with Miso is inspired by the traditional Japanese dish «Nasu Dengaku». To give the classic version an extra twist, I added citrusy flavours, and if you like some hot red chilies.

Preparation I Wash and cut the eggplant into 15 mm thick slices. Put them in a large bowl with cold water to remove the bitterness and set aside.

Preheat the oven to 180° C.

In a saucepan mix the Miso paste, the Mirin, Kikkoman Ponzu soy sauce, the sugar and the Dashi broth together and warm the sauce over low heat. Add the lime juice and keep stirring until you have a thick yet still liquid sauce.

Take the eggplant slices out of the water and dab them dry. Then cut cross-wise incisions into the flesh on one side of each slice — but don't cut completely through.

Place the slices — the side with the incisions facing up — on a baking parchment covered tray and brush or spoon the miso sauce on top of each one of them.

Bake the slices for 40 minutes in the oven. After 20 minutes you can brush some more of the sauce on the slices and then continue to bake.

Thinly cut the spring onion and, if you like, the red chilies into rings. Toast the sesame seeds in a pan until slightly coloured.

Serving I Place the slices on plates, sprinkle with the roasted sesame seeds, spring onion and red chilles and serve with white rice and a wedge of lime — enjoy!

#### Ingredients per eggplant

1 medium-size egaplant

1 small spring onion

1 red chilli

2 limes

3 Tbsp White Miso paste

2 Tbsp Mirin (sweet rice wine)

1 Tbsp Kikkoman Ponzu soy sauce

4 Tbsp Dashi broth or

vegetable broth

1 tsp sugar

Preparation time: 15 minutes, baking time 40 minutes. Serves 2

Circus Oz to explore new artistic directions:

Australia's national circus company, Circus Oz has announced exciting new artistic plans that will reposition the company within the new National Performing Arts Partnerships Framework announced at the Meeting of Cultural Ministers in October 2019.

In 2020, Circus Oz will introduce a new guest director program that will explore the artistic potential of the company and enable a range of artistic leaders to experiment with different forms and formats.

CIRCUS

Working with a new core group of full-time performers and other creative artists, the program will leverage the world-class facilities at the Circus Oz headquarters in Collingwood to expand the possibilities of contemporary circus.

Led by Circus Oz Executive Director Penny Miles, this revived approach forms part of a renewed vision for the company that will examine, challenge and trial future artistic directions.

"As a company that pioneered contemporary circus, this is a pivotal time for Circus Oz to consider what our place is now. Circus is a dynamic and evolving sector that looks very different today than it did 20, 10, or even five years ago," said Miles.

Miles explained that Circus Oz has recently reviewed and scrutinized their place in the Australian and international creative sector, "The new National Performing Arts Partnerships Framework is a catalyst to reinforce and intensify our extraordinary strength and spirit, which holds a very special place in the hearts of many Australians. As well as showcasing phenomenal circus and providing unique platforms for social issues and commentary, we will emphasize our crucial role in supporting the circus sector, in particular providing pathways for independent and First Nations artists."

"In Australia we are fortunate to have an extraordinary pool of talented circus artists. Through our diverse programs at Circus Oz — including Sidesault, Strong Women and BLAKflip — we are seeing energetic, intriguing and provocative new ways to experience circus," Miles highlighted.

"We take our role in supporting a vibrant Australian circus sector very seriously, and — if complemented with increased and targeted government investment in independent artists and small to medium organisations — our sector could be world-leading," Miles stated.

"Our renewed vision will allow us to support the next generation of circus pioneers, while providing an incubator for new works as we discover and expose the best artistic leadership models for Circus Oz," said Miles.

Building on the remarkable Circus Oz legacy, the future-focus for the company will include a number of intensive creative developments rolled out in 2020.

Over the coming months, Circus Oz will search for guest directors and creatives to explore the artistic potential of the company.

Further updates announcements are anticipated in early 2020.

Melbourne Queer Film Festival (MQFF) is marking its 30th festival by unveiling a new brand and marketing campaign that embodies the essence of queer film. The new festival tagline 'We're Stories in Every Colour' highlights the MQFF ethos of inclusion, community and celebration of LGBTIQ+ people.



"In this milestone anniversary year we wanted to ensure that we celebrate the diversity of the queer voice, while championing the people that have made it possible to bring these important queer stories to the screen over the past 30

years. Stories in Every Colour is a great way to showcase the diversity, history, talent and programming that makes MQFF such an important cultural event for Melbourne and LGBTIQ+ communities," said Maxwell Gratton, Chief Executive Officer. "We are also proud, with the support of our sponsors, supporters, members and sweethearts that we can continue to fund the next generation of Australian queer filmmakers to tell the stories of our communities."

The festival programme which is spread across central, the north and south of Melbourne boasts over 140 sessions encompassing Australian and International features, documentaries and shorts, Q&A sessions, workshops and parties to unify and celebrate LGBTIQ+ culture and queer cinema. As part of the new campaign launch, MQFF announced the first six titles that will form part of MQFF30 dynamic programming to be played across the Capitol Theatre, Cinema Nova and Jam Factory, including;

#### Unsound

On returning home from the UK, Noah (Reece Noi, Game of Thrones) a disillusioned musician finds creative inspiration and love via a community led dance club which is run by the headstrong Finn (Yiana Pandelis), a hearing-impaired trans-man on the cusp of transitioning. This Australian feature provides a delicate representation of love, respect, empathy and acceptance and features singer Christine Anu in a supporting role.

#### Seguin in a Blue Room

This debut Australian feature is a daring and provocative exploration of a young man's sexuality in the age of social media and online dating apps.

#### Tell It To The Bees

This touching and romantic adaptation of Fiona Shaw's much loved novel stars Oscar winner Anna Paquin, as a doctor in 1950s small town Scotland, who develops a passionate relationship with her young patient's mother, played by Holliday Grainger. The two women face deep rooted prejudice as their bond deepens to love, causing scandal and recrimination amongst the close-knit community.

#### The Shiny Shrimps

This raucous comedy tells the 'mostly' true story of a French water polo team wreaking havoc at the Croatian gay games. Think Priscilla in Speedos.

#### **Queering The Script**

Buffy the Vampire Slayer, Xena: Warrior Princess, The L Word, just to name a few are given the spotlight in this immensely enjoyable documentary about lesbian characters on TV and the women who love them.

"The lives, passions, struggles and successes of queer communities are as diverse as our acronym and this year's program will showcase some of the best stories from Australian and international film-makers to our festival. Melbourne Queer Film Festival is about sharing the important stories of our community with our community. Get ready to be inspired, provoked, entertained and moved with this year's selection of films," said Spiro Economopoulos, MQFF Program Director.
